## NOTES FROM THE CANTOR

### THE MUSIC OF POLAND

As many of you remember, I was part of a historic mission to Poland last summer, organized by the Cantors Assembly.



We toured and sang in Warsaw and Krakow. The Friday night service that we experienced was an attempt to replicate what may have been heard in the Tempel (Progressive) Synagogue in Krakow before the Jewish population was decimated during World War II. While no actual records exist of what music was employed in the synagogue, my colleague, Hazzan Joseph Gole of Los Angeles, put together a predominantly choral service that I would like to share with the congregation at this year's Annual Sharon Barshay Music Service on Friday evening, June 11, at 8:00 p.m. The Adult Choir and I will also present other significant Jewish music of the period.

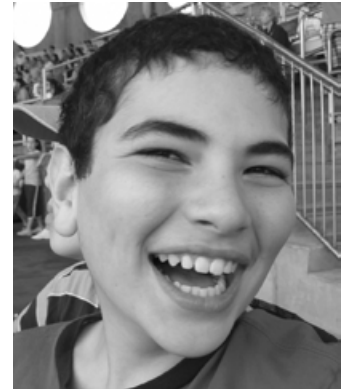

## EMANUEL MITZVAH HERO — ED MICHAELS

Ed Michaels understands what it's like to need a mentor. His father died when Ed was seven years old. Fortunately, his mother arranged for him to get a "Big Brother." It made a lifelong difference for Ed, who now volunteers as a "Big Brother" himself.

"I used to wait by the window for his car to pull up," Ed says. "Today, he and I are still best friends."

Big Brothers/Big Sisters is a national organization that matches volunteers with young people who need an extra adult presence in their lives, helping them to become productive, responsible adults.

Ed is "Big Brother" to a young man from Hartford, matched three years ago when the boy was ten. "He lives in an apartment with ailing grandparents and doesn't get out much. There is no father, the mother

is a drug addict," says Ed. Ed takes him to Wolfpack games, shoots hoops and bowls with him, or they hit the batting cages. Sometimes Ed's son comes along.

"The time varies. My commitment is to the boy, not to the number of hours I spend." On average, Ed sees his "little brother" twice a month.

Volunteers of all types join the program — including college students, childless people, and grandparents. There's a real need for more mentors. The Nutmeg branch of BB/BS serves towns throughout the state.

Ed's mentoring is an example of Ahavah V'reyut, the mitzvah of caring for another person. Ed says he does it because it's the right thing to do. He loves the satisfaction of seeing the smile on his "little brother's" face, and



it offers hope. "This kid was on a really bad path. Now he plans to go into a trade when he grows up."

## THE JOB CLUB — WHAT'S THE MOST CRITICAL FACTOR IN FINDING A JOB?

Having a job-search strategy — and following it. Besides having some sort of plan, the other key issue is having the tenacity to stick with it — and adjust it as necessary — for as long as it takes. There are no magic formulas or guarantees. Job hunting is hard work, but the more you plan, and the more committed you are to finding a new job, the better your chances.

So, with that introduction, here are the 9 steps to finding a new job.

**Step 1:** Examine your life/career. Are you where you want to be in your career? How well does your current job and career path meet your life goals? Do you feel as though your life and career are in or out of balance? Be completely honest with yourself in answering these questions.

**Step 2:** Set career/job-search goals. Create a vision of where you see yourself in six months; in six years.

Research careers, jobs, and employers. Be sure all of your goals are realistic.

**Step 3:** Reconnect with/expand your network. Your network of personal contacts is the most powerful job-search tool under your control. Expand, build, and strengthen your network.

**Step 4:** Upgrade your knowledge/skills. Employers want employees who have a set of what's termed "soft" skills, including communications (written and verbal), interpersonal, teamwork, problem-solving, analytical, and adaptability.

**Step 5:** Consider additional training/education. One of the best ways to improve your employability is to gain additional knowledge, training, or certification.

**Step 6:** Update/polish your resume. There are so many new rules of resume-writing, including different for-

mat and versions, that you best spend a fair amount of time on this step

**Step 7:** Learn/refresh job-search techniques. Do you know how to generate job leads? How to use your network? You must stay current with the latest job-search techniques.

**Step 8:** Practice interviewing. One of the most overlooked areas of job-hunting is preparing and practicing for job interviews. Research the employer, and practice answering common interview questions.

**Step 9:** Test your marketability. Job hunting is all about marketing yourself to employers. Determine what makes you unique among all other job seekers.
