FROM THE RABBI — STORIES OF BECOMING, CREATIVITY AND INSPIRATION IN THE EMANUEL FAMILY

Sandra Myers and Ben Engel’s stories illustrate the best of synagogue life at The Emanuel. Sandra Myers celebrated her adult Bat Mitzvah in May. Sandra’s story represents the best of Emanuel Synagogue. We encourage our members to pursue their personal growth in a loving community, inspired by the teachings of Torah and expressed through the riches of Jewish life and culture.

Sandra, as she explained in her *dvar torah*, was not especially encouraged to become a Bat Mitzvah when she was a girl. Last year, a gentle suggestion by Cantor Sanford Cohn planted the notion that she might follow the example of her sister Emily and become adult bat mitzvah. Supported and mentored by Judy Fox in Hebrew, Hazan Cohn in *tefilah*, *Torah* and *Haftarab*, Sandra applied herself month after month to the learning. She revised draft upon draft of her *dvar torah*, weaving the themes of the Torah portion into her family’s lore and major events of her own life.

The Shabbat of her Bat Mitzvah, Sandra drew together many strands of her life. She incorporated into the Bat Mitzvah service a celebration of 41 years of marriage to Mike, her niece Danielle’s *auf ruf* blessing and a naming blessing for her granddaughter “Lexi” born to Leah and Charles Eisenberg. This Shabbat service epitomized Emanuel at our best. We inspire, challenge and support our members to learn and grow. We provide a genuine synagogue family, a place to celebrate the important passages of life and add meaning in the presence of people who genuinely care. This sense of kinship is rare in today’s society, and precious indeed.

Ben Engel has proven that Fitzgerald was wrong. There *are* second acts in American lives. Already well established as an attorney, husband and father, a past President of the Emanuel, Ben has found his muse and emerged as a home-grown Jewish playwright. Ben’s first effort, *Jacob and Esau*, debuted as a reader’s theater performance last year to an audience of hundreds from across the community. The production brought together a wonderful group of volunteer performers and production crew whose talents came together to create an outstanding and meaningful experience.

Not content with this initial triumph, Ben embarked upon his second effort, set in the Rabbinic period: *Rabbi of the Stars*. Like *Jacob and Esau* it explores the themes of human relationship, rivalry and jealousy in a setting of seeking to understand and fulfill Divine will, as expressed in the lives of Rabban Gamaliel and other Sages of ancient Judea. Ben and his colleagues suggested that a program of congregational learning might precede the debut of the play in December, to set the stage for the play and familiarize the congregation with the teachings and lives of the Sages. To that end, Rabbi Philip Lazowski taught a seven-week series, “Secrets of Pirkei Avot” and in November, Rabbi David Hoffman of JTS will serve as a Scholar in Residence, teaching on the Sages as human beings. Ben’s story is another example of our synagogue’s potential to help inspire and support the talents, inspiration and creativity of our members. Please consider how you might challenge yourself to learn and grow, create and celebrate with the support of your Emanuel family.

RELIGIOUS SCHOOL NEWS

Emanuel Religious School is very proud of our committed and talented faculty. Most of our teachers have been with our school for over ten years. On May 15th we had a whole school Israel Independence Day program planned and led by our faculty. This program was called “Journey Through the Cities of Israel.” Students went to different rooms that represented different regions of Israel.

The religious school hallway was transformed into the Kotel. This station was led by Beckie Sahl and Deborah Mehlman. The students learned about the temple history and the Kotel. They wrote blessings they would like for their friends and family on sticky notes and then stuck them to a Jerusalem stone wall on the bimah. Students at this station also played a quiz game where they learned about the tradition in the Torah called “Shalosh Regalim” where the Israelites would visit Jerusalem three times a year to take their harvest to the temple.

Northern Israel and Tsfat was set up in the activity room and was led by Robin Rosenthal and Robin Herman. Students learned about how kabbalah was developed in Tsfat. Students discovered that many of the kabbalistic traditions from Tsfat we still keep today, for example, wearing white to greet the Shabbat bride. Students also learned about the art you find in Tsfat including micrography. Students worked together to create their micrography depicting the Torah scroll using the words of the prayer “L’Cha Dodi.”

Joelle Jenkins and Fay Mannheim led a station on Haifa. The students there learned about how Jews and Arabs live and work together peacefully. Students played a game where they identified the differences between life in Israel for Druze, Palestinians, and Israelis.

The Negev station was led by Nancy Fichman. At this station we created a Bedouin tent for the students to sit in as their teacher, Nancy, taught them about the culture and history of the Negev. At this station the students got to eat hummus and pita. They put mud masks from the Dead Sea on as well.

The last station was Tel Aviv led by Carolyn Topol. We recreated the Tel Aviv boardwalk complete with a backdrop of the famous Tel Aviv shoreline. Students got to try a special drink at the cafe called “limonada,” which is crushed ice with fresh mint and lemon.

We look forward to many more experiential and creative programs planned by our faculty!

Current and Upcoming B'Yadeynu Projects

• B'Yadeynu recently formed a subcommittee called the **CT Coalition for Yazidi Relief**. The subcommittee held its fourth meeting at the end of May. Susan Rosenstein, chair of the committee, is in contact with the offices of Senator Murphy and Senator Blumenthal about this crisis, which the Holocaust Museum, the EU and the United States have all concluded constitutes genocide. At the time of this writing the committee was reviewing various ways to support relief efforts of organizations working directly to provide assistance to Yazidi refugees and other refugees impacted by trauma. The committee is planning multiple educational events to raise public awareness about this crisis. Please contact Janet Wallans or Risa Davidson if you would like to join this subcommittee (contact info below).

• **Tara's Closet** is a newly launched Jewish Family Services program that has caught B'Yadeynu's attention. The goals of Tara's Closet include providing clothing to JFS clients in a confidential and dignified manner as well as raising funds to spread awareness about mental illness and the related help provided by JFS.
