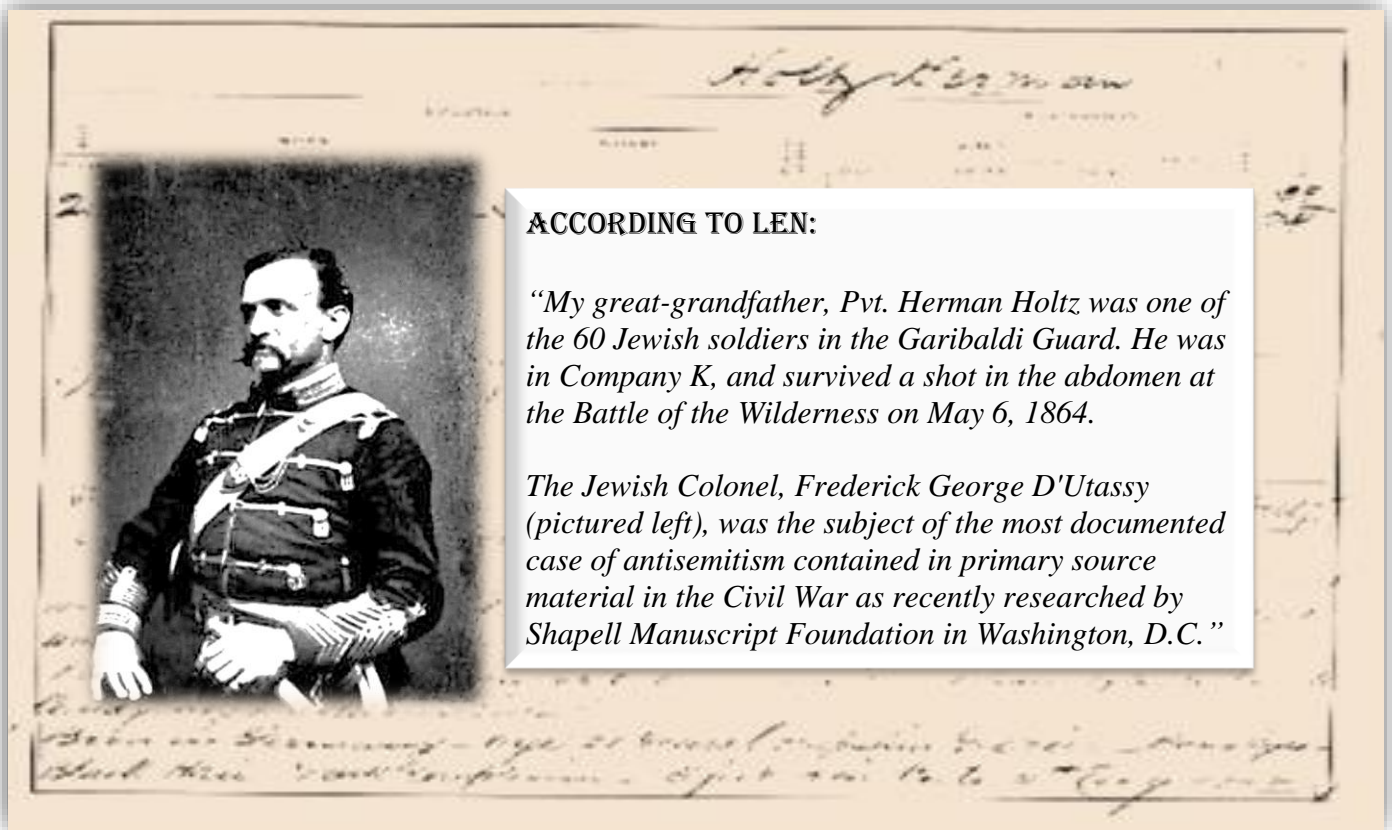

“My great-grandfather, Pvt. Herman Holtz was one of the 60 Jewish soldiers in the Garibaldi Guard. He was in Company K, and survived a shot in the abdomen at the Battle of the Wilderness on May 6, 1864.

The Jewish Colonel, Frederick George D'Utassy (pictured left), was the subject of the most documented case of antisemitism contained in primary source material in the Civil War as recently researched by Shapell Manuscript Foundation in Washington, D.C.”
