## FROM THE RABBI

### LOVE IN THE AIR — THE MEANING OF ELUL



Thanks to the lunar calendar, this year we observe the month of Elul during September. Elul is the month that precedes Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur, or “the Days of Awe.” Elul offers us the chance to prepare for the New Year, physically, relationally and spiritually. Elul gives

us the impetus to clean house, literally and figuratively. This is a season for putting things in physical order, taking inventory, and performing needed repairs. The same holds true for relationships and our spiritual lives. Elul is a great time to take inventory, put things in order and repair our relationships with the people around, within ourselves, and with our Creator.

Love offers us the best way to carry out this work. If we approach our family, friends and community, ourselves and our Creator with love, then many forms of repair become possible. Rabbi Edwin Freedman teaches that, when parties are moving toward each other, anything is possible. When parties are moving away from each other, very little is possible. (*Generation to Generation: Family Process in Church and Synagogue*)

A student of Reb Nachman of Breslov observes that “love is giving unreservedly of oneself to another” (*love-breslov.org*). A full spirit of giving, without reservation, without keeping score or holding on to resentments, can free us from “blockages” in our relationships and in our lives. Love can help us become unstuck. Reb Nachman observes that the letters of the month of Elul form an acronym for “*Ani Ledodi veDodi Li*” which means, “I am for my beloved, and my beloved is for me” or, “I am moving toward my beloved and my beloved is moving toward me.” Caring and giving generate healing and allow us to move forward.

Hatred and vitriol abound in our world. We have the choice whether to add to the hate or increase the love. Our individual decisions and actions add up. Each of us has a chance to redeem our own corner of the world. And may our love emanate beyond the confines of our homes and synagogues to effect healing in our society.

## FROM THE PRESIDENT



### *A Season of Return*

“There’s no place like home, there’s no place like home, there’s no place

like home...” Clicking the heels of her ruby slippers, Dorothy Gale makes ready to return to the plains of Kansas as she leaves the Technicolor wonders of the Emerald City and the amazing friends she has made on a dream-like journey where she overcomes dangers and personal challenges. What is it about the gray familiar landscape of Dorothy’s home that moves her to endlessly pursue the familiar over the magical wonders of Oz? It is a mystical question that we of the Jewish faith have pondered for centuries. What is home and where do we find it?

This month, the month of *Elul*, we begin a journey toward redemption, toward return. Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur are approaching. We will be called to reckon, to examine our personal balance sheet. The Almighty has scheduled an audit, but it is we who must tally our deeds. I feel a sense of building anxiety and at the same time hope knowing I will fall short of the ideal but still intent on being a better person. I have wronged. I didn’t listen when my friends and family needed me. I was cavalier when seriousness was warranted. When empathy was called for I was judgmental. How can I right these wrongs? To whom do I owe apologies? Searching for the path of repentance, I am buoyed by our calendar’s wondrous timetable. There is time to repent, to pray, to offer *tzedakah* and to confess.

On Yom Kippur, the book will close. Will the gates be ajar for me? Between Rosh Hashana and the Day of Atonement, I will cram, but during *Elul*, there is time. Our season of return is coming. Traditionally, during *Elul* the shofar is sounded

each non-Shabbos morning. It is a reminder of where we are heading but also of where we have been. It is a reminder that our faith offers all a return ticket. *Teshuvah* means to return. To what or where are we commanded to return? Soon we will recite the *Al Chet*, the long list of human transgressions. *Chet* means to go astray. *Teshuvah* are the acts that return us to the path of righteousness. What keeps me up at night? What actions must I take?

I am wracked with guilt this year. What have I done to welcome the stranger? What does our story compel of me? What have I learned? How does a Jew return? How does an ancient Israelite return home when the Romans have sacked Jerusalem? How does a Sephardi Spaniard go home to Gerona when to do so means conversion or death? How does a survivor of Auschwitz return to a city that has been destroyed to a home that has been occupied? These are not my transgressions nor was I there to offer help, but what do these stories

ask of me today? What does it mean when we declare, Never Again?

I must answer these questions this month and next and beyond. To reckon with our worldly challenges, to make a difference in others’ lives, *Elul* and *Tisbri* call me to action. I will not look away when the poor ask for relief. I will not feign apathy when our politics offend me. I will not focus inward when others have no home to return to. I will give thanks for my bounty. I will offer support to those in need and be there when called. Like Moses, I will pay for my transgressions, but even if the ultimate return to the Promised Land is beyond my fate, I will never stop striving to return to the path of goodness.

I am hopeful that all of you, the Emanuel family, find the coming High Holy Days introspective and comforting and that we all find peace when we gather with our families in our spiritual home during this season of return.

## NOTES FROM THE CANTOR

### THE JOURNEY...SO FAR (PART IV)

Although I began my studies at the Jewish Theological Seminary (JTS) on what I considered

a trial basis, the subjects I studied quickly captivated me. The classes fell into three categories: pure Judaica (Hebrew language, basic Jewish law), pure music (sight-reading, theory, music history), and Jewish music (nusah, cantillation, history of Jewish music). Most of my instructors were world-renown experts in their respective fields who had profound effects on me and whose voices I still hear in my head: Hazzanim Max Wohlberg (z"l) and Charles Davidson, Professor Albert Weisser (z"l), composers Miriam Gideon (z"l) and Lazar Weiner (z"l) and Rabbi Morton Leifman (z"l), who served as director of the school and as a father figure to us students. We had a school choir conducted by Matthew "Mati" Lazar, who also taught conducting and learned music for teaching religious school classes with Hazzan David Tilman.

In those days, 1978-1982, both the Rabbinical School and Cantors Institute were strictly for male students, although a few female students took cantorial classes and eventually became hazzanim. Some women also took classes in Talmud and rabbinics, and thus I was fortunate to meet my future wife Beth. (She eventually studied law at New York University, but that's a story for another time.)

While enrolled at JTS, some experiences beyond the classroom helped prepare me for congregational work. Beginning in my second year I assumed student pulpits, first for

High Holy Days only, then on a monthly basis, and finally 2-3 times per week. In various communities in the Tri-State area I began to develop my skills in leading services and in teaching B'nei Mitzvah. The pulpit in my fourth year also served as a lesson in dealing with high stress, as I had to ride a series of trains and buses to a small town in New Jersey at least twice a week to lead services and give Bar/Bat Mitzvah lessons. There were so many students and so little time, each student only received 20 minutes of my time!

In my third and fourth years, I would ride the subway to The Bronx

once a week with a fellow student to sing to oncology patients at the Montefiore Medical Center. We would try to find songs from each patient's ethnic background or other selections that were meaningful. I learned how important music can be to people experiencing health crises, and how to communicate with them in empathetic ways.

For two summers, I worked at Camp Ramah of Wisconsin, first as a counselor in the Tikvah Program for children with special needs. This was not my first experience working with this population, but it was the

## TASHLICH OPTIONS ON ROSH HASHANAH AFTERNOON

As in previous years, the Tashlich ceremony, held on the afternoon of Rosh Hashanah (this year on Sept. 30, at 5 p.m.), will be conducted at two locations: On Trout Brook Drive in West Hartford, we will gather at a small stream across the street from the former UConn campus. In Simsbury, Tashlich will be held on the east bank of the Farmington River where the landmark Pinchot Sycamore tree — the largest tree in Connecticut — stands at the base of Talcott Mountain, south of the town center of Simsbury.

The ritual is performed at a large, natural body of flowing water (e.g., river, lake, sea, or ocean). During the Tashlich ceremony, we recite a biblical passage and symbolically throw our sins into a source of water. Some throw small pieces of bread into the water.

**SUKKOT HOME OBSERVANCE**

The Festival of Sukkot offers several opportunities for home observances.

-  Blessing and waving the *arba minim*, a.k.a. the *lulav* and *etrog*, can be done every day of the Festival except on Shabbat. Sitting in the sukkah can be done any day of the festival.
-  Don't own a *lulav* and *etrog*? Come use the set we have at The Emanuel.
-  Don't have a sukkah this year? Visit a friend or neighbor who has one. Also, the sukkah at The Emanuel is available for you.
-  Eating a meal or snack and even sleeping in the sukkah enhances the fulfillment of the mitzvah, "To dwell in the sukkah."
